The Superintending Engineer, WBTDCL invites e-Tender for the following work(s) from the eligible Contractors as detailed in the table below. [Collection (downloading) and Submission (uploading) of Tender can be made online through the website https://wbtenders.gov.in only].

The digitally signed quoted rate will only be encrypted both the B.O.O. i.e. for percentage rate and item rate under financial bid at Sheet-1 and Sheet-2 in BOO respectively.

2. Bidder shall not have to pay the cost of tender documents for the purpose of participating in e-tendering, however, only the successful Bidder will be required to deposit cost of Technical, Financial Bid documents, 2911 & others Annexure, in favour of respective Executive Engineer of the concerned Division as mentioned in list of schemes of NIT against each work before executing formal agreement. {Ref: PWD No. 199-CRC/2M-10/2012 Dated 21/12/2012 & 24-A/2D-13/2010 Dated 31/01/2014}.

Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):-The amount of Earnest Money to be submitted through e-procurement system as per F.D memorandum No. 3975-F(Y) Dt. - 28, July, 2016.

In every case of open e-tender an earnest money amounting to 2% of the estimated value of the work put to tender or Rs. 10.00 Lakh, whichever is lower shall be required to be deposited by every tenderer/bidder along with each tender (Ref: Gazette Notification No 137/1-A/PW/O/10C-02/14 Dated 24/04/2014). Earnest Money is to be submitted online as mentioned in Clause-1.

- 3. Refund of EMD: As per P.W.D., Government of West Bengal Memo no:-148-W(C)/1M-23/15 Dt:- 16.03.2018.
- 4. Tender is to be submitted (uploaded) in **Technical Proposal and Financial Proposal**. Both Technical Proposal and Financial proposal should be submitted duly digitally signed by the Tenderer through the website **https://wbtenders.gov.in** as per the 'Date & Time Schedule' stated in Sl. No.15. of this N.I.T. (Details of which has been narrated in **'Instruction to Bidders'**).

5. A. Eligibility criteria for participation in tender :

- i) Intending tenderer should produce credentials of similar nature of completed work of the minimum value of 40% of the estimated amount put to tender during 5(Five) years prior to the date of issue of the tender notice; or,
- ii) Intending tenderers should produce credentials of 2(two) similar nature of completed work, each of minimum value of 30% of the estimated amount put to tender during 5(Five) years prior to the date of issue of the tender notice; or
- iii) Intending tenderers should produce credentials of 1(one) single running work of similar nature which has been completed to the extent of 80% or more and value of which is not less than the desired value at (i) above; In case of running works, only those tenderers who will submit the certificate of satisfactory running work from the concerned Executive Engineer, or equivalent competent authority will be eligible for the tender. In the required certificate it should be clearly stated that the work is in progress satisfactorily and also that no penal action has been initiated against the executed agency, i.e., the tenderer. N.B.: Work completed within time period or justifiable extended time period will get advantage.
- iv) Copy's of Audited Balance Sheet [audited by Chartered ACCOUNTANT (s)] relating to Financial Years: 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23duly certified by members of Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI), accompanied by 'Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) along with copies of Form No. 3CA/3CB, as the case may be, and 3CD and 26AS for each respective financial Years, as prescribed under Section 44AB of the Income Tax ACT,1961.
- v) The prospective Tenderers shall have in their full time engagement experienced technical personal, the minimum being one Civil Engineering Degree holder and one Civil Engineering Diploma holder. An undertaking is to be given in this respect as per proforma "ITB Section B, form IV" [Non-statutory Documents]



- Note: Credential certificate issued by the Executive Engineer of equivalent or competent authority of a State/ Central Government, State/ Central Government undertaking, Statutory /Autonomous bodies constituted under the central / State statute, on the executed value of completed/ running work will be taken as credential. (G.O.No.04-A/PWDO/10C-02/14 date 18.03.2015 of PWD). Payment certificate will not be treated as credential. Amount of Final Bill,Estimate Amount, Date of commencement, Date of completion of the work and detailed communicational address along with contact number of the Client should be submitted by the Tenderer. [Non-statutory Documents].
- vi) All categories of prospective Tenderers shall have to submit valid and up to date Professional Tax receipt Challan, Valid 15-digit Goods and Services Taxpayer Identification numbers (GSTIN) under GST Act -2017, Income Tax Return Acknowledgement Receipt, PAN Card issued by Income Tax Department, Voter ID Card and Trade Licence in respect of the prospective Tenderer. [Non-statutory Documents]
- vii) Where an individual person holds a Digital Signature Certificate in his own name duly issued to him by the company or the firm of which he happens to be a director or partner, such individual person, either belonging to an appropriate cadre officer of the company or an authorized partner of a firm, having a registered power of attorney empowered by the board or by the firm, shall invariably upload a copy of registered power of attorney showing clear authorization in his favour, to upload such tender.
 - The power of attorney shall have to be registered in accordance with the provisions of the Registration Act, 1908. [Non-statutory Documents][Order No. 09-W(C)/1M-286/15 Date-23.09.2015]
- viii) Neither prospective Tenderer nor any of the constituent partners had been debarred to participate in any Tender by the WBTDCL, PWD, PW(R)D & Social Sector, PWD te (Formerly Known as P.W.(C.B.)Dte), Housing Department, W.B. during the last 5 (five) years prior to the date of this NIT. Such debarring will be considered as disqualification towards eligibility. (a declaration in this respect has to be furnished by the prospective bidders as per prescribed format). [Non-statutory Documents]
- In case of Proprietorship and Partnership Firms, the Tax Audit Report under I.T.Act in 3CD Form and in case of Private Limited Company, the Audit Report under Companies Act is to be furnished alongwith Balance Sheet, Profit & Loss Account for the last 5 years (year just preceding the current financial year will be considered as year –1) including all schedules forming the part of Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account. The Balance Sheet, Profit & Loss Account should be in favour of applicant. No other name along with applicant's name in such enclosure will be entertained.[Non-statutory Documents]
- x) The partnership firm shall furnish the Registered Partnership Deed and the Company shall furnish the Memorandum of Association (MOA) and Article of Association (AOA.) [Non-statutory Documents]
- xi) Registered Un-employed Engineers' Co-operative Societies / Labour Co- operative Societies are required to furnish the following documents: [Non-statutory Documents]
 - a) Current "No Objection Certificate" from the Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies.
 - b) Supporting documents showing area of operation.
 - c) Bye-laws duly approved by the Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies.
 - d) Name with address and signature of the present Board of Directors of the Co-operative Society.
 - e) Minutes of last Annual General Meeting and Audit Report of the Co-operative Society with the evidence of submission of the same to the concerned Authorities.
- xii) The prospective tenderers should own/ lease/ arrange the required plant and machinery. List and conclusive proof of machinery in working condition shall have to be submitted. (Non-Statutory documents)
- xiii) The prospective tenderers or any of their constituent partner shall neither have abandoned any work nor any of their contract have been rescinded during the last 5 (five) years. Such abandonment or rescission will be considered as disqualification towards eligibility.
- xiv) Joint Ventures for civil work will not be allowed.
- **xv)** A prospective Tenderer shall be allowed to participate in the job either in the capacity of individual or as a partner of a firm. If found to have applied severally in a single job, all his applications will be rejected for that job.
- xvi) No conditional / Incomplete Tender will be accepted under any circumstances.
- xvii) The Bidder's Net Worth for the last year calculated on the basis of Capital, Profit and free Reserve available to the firm should be Positive. [Non Statutory Documents (Financial Statement)]
- xviii) The available Bid Capacity [to be calculated on the basis of prescribed format (ITB, Section B, Form II)] of the prospective Tenderer shallnot be less than the amount put to tender. [Non Statutory Documents (Financial Statement)]. [Payment certificate/Form No. 26AS for that particular year over which Bid Capacity will be calculated is to be submitted for ready reference]
- xix) The maximum gross Turn Over of the particular F.Y. shown to evaluate Bid Capacity should match with the 26AS/Payment Certificate.
- **Attached ITB, Section-B: Form-I, II, III, IV,V, and AFFIDAVIT-X,Y&Z and Annexure should be filled up duly and uploadedaccordingly.**
- xxi) ESI and PF registration certificate, up to date challan for EPF subscription & up to date return for proof of payment of EPF dues of the workers (last 6 (six) months ECR & e-challan in separate).

B. If Electrical Works Included then following Documents should be submitted.

The Bidder must have,

- i. Valid Electrical Contractor License issued by the Licensing Board, Govt. of West Bengal.
- ii. Valid Electrical S.C.C. Part No. 1, 2, 4, 7A, 10 & 11 issued by the Licensing Board, Govt. of West Bengal or equivalent National Supervisors' Certificate of Competency as per the Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to safety and electric supply)



Regulation 2010 (erstwhile I.E. Rules 1956) read with guidelines issues from time to time by Directorate of Electricity, Govt. of West Bengal.

- iii. Credential in respect of similar nature of Electrical Works at least 1 No. valuing 40% of the Electrical Estimated amount put to tender within last 5 years prior to the date of issue of the tender notice.
- iv. To ensure presence of Licensed Electrical Supervisor during execution of Electrical Works.
- v. To engage Licensed Electricians for execution of the work.

or

In case the intending bidder has no electrical papers of his own, then Joint Venture of Civil and with electrical counterparts will be allowed for the particular work through MOU (Memorandum of Understanding) which should be notarised as per Court of Law and the same is to be documented through e-Filing. In that case, the electrical contractor will have to qualify for all the requirements set forth in the NIT for electrical works including credential, electrical supervisor's certificate of competency (SCC) etc. The Civil Contractor will be to qualify for all requirements set forth in the NIT including requisite credential for Civil components of such works but excluding credential and SCC requirement for electrical works. However, the onus and full responsibility for execution of the total work (Civil & Electrical) will be on the civil contractor who will execute the agreement with the Department. Payment will also be made to the civil contractor only. (Ref: Memorandum No. 311-W(C)/1M-132/15 dated 28.03.2018 of the Additional Chief Secretary, P.W.Department, Govt. of West Bengal).

C. If Fire Fighting Works Included then following Documents should be submitted:

The bidder must have Credential in respect of similar nature of Fire Fighting System at least 1 No. valuing 40% of the estimated amount put to tender of Fire Fighting System within last 5 years prior to the date of issue of the tender notice.

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In case the intending bidder has no papers of Fire Fighting System of his own, then Joint Venture of Civil and with the counterparts of Fire Fighting System will be allowed for the particular work through MOU (Memorandum of Understanding) which should be notarised as per Court of Law and the same is to be documented through e-Filing.

In case of running works, only those tenderers /bidders who will submit the certificate of satisfactory running work from the concerned Executive Engineer, or equivalent competent authority will be eligible for the tender. In the required certificate it should be clearly stated that the work is in progress satisfactorily and also that no penal action has been initiated against the executing agency, i.e. the tenderer/bidders.

N.B.: ALL THE DOCUMENTS STATED ABOVE FOR EXECUTION OF ELECTRICAL WORKS IS TO BE UPLOADED ALONG WITH THE TENDER.

- 6. a) Agencies shall have to arrange for required Plant & Machineries, store of materials, labour shed, laboratory etc. and land for creation of the same at their own cost and responsibility nearest to the work side.
 - b) **Toilet speciality** to be provided at side by the agency at his own cost.
- The prospective Tenderer shall establish field testing laboratory equipped with necessary instruments and technical staff according to the requirements of works to be executed.
- 8. Work Order or Payment of work will be depended on availability of fund. Intending tenderers may consider this-criteria while submission of Tender and quoting their rates.
- 9. Bid shall remain valid for a period not less than 120(One Hundred Twenty) days after the dead line date for Financial Bid / Sealed Bid submission. Bid validity for a shorter period shall be rejected by the Tender Accepting Authority as non-responsive.

If any tenderer withdraws his offer before Bid validity period without giving any satisfactory explanation for such withdrawals, he may be disqualified for submitting tender to WBTDCL for minimum period of 1(one) year and legal action will be taken against him.

- A. A person / entity that is forbidden on suspended / debarred by a procuring entity are not allowed to participate in any procurement process under WBTDCL during the period of suspension / debarment unless the same is revoked.
- B. A joint venture or consortium which is suspended / debarred or which has suspended / debarred member/s and/or partner/s as well as a person / entity who is a member of a suspended / debarred joint venture or consortium is not allowed to participate in any procurement process under WBTDCL during the period of suspension / debarment unless the same is revoked.
- C. The decision of debarment/ suspension committee for debarment / suspension of a bidder formed under pwd memo no 547-w(c)/1m-387/15 dt\:- 16-11-2015 is final for upon all concerned.

10. Materials, laying in different stack-yards under this circle may be issued in the work for the interest of public works.

- 11. The Tenderer, at the Tenderer's own responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit and examine the site of works and its surroundings and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the Tender and entering into a contract for the work as mentioned in the Notice Inviting Tender, the cost of visiting the site shall be at the Tenderer's own expense.
- 12. The Superintending Engineer, WBTDCL, reserves the right to cancel this N.I.T. due to unavoidable circumstances and no claim in this respect will be entertained.
- 13. The intending Tenderers shall clearly understand that whatever may be the outcome of the present Invitation of Tender, no cost of Tendering shall be reimbursable by the Department. The Superintending Engineer, WBTDCL, reserves the right to reject any Tender or all Tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever and is not liable for any cost that might have incurred by any Tenderer at any stage of Tendering.

- 16. All Tenderers are requested to be present at the Superintending Engineer, WBTDCL, during opening of the Tender to observe the tender opening procedure. The Superintending Engineer, WBTDCL may call Open Bid/Sealed Bid after opening of the said tender to obtain the suitable rate further, if it is required. No objections in this respect will be entertained raised by any Tenderer who will be absent at the time of opening of Tender. No informal tenderer will be entertained in the Bid further.
- 17. Security Deposit: In respect of successful Tenderer, the Earnest Money on acceptance of Tender shall be converted as a part of the Security Deposit. The successful Tenderer who deposited Earnest Money @ 2% of the amount put to the Tender, balance of necessary 10% (Ten percent) Security Deposit shall be realised by recovering from the progressive bill @ 8% (Eight percent) of the amount of each such bill.
- 18. In all cases the amount of recovery of the Final Bill will be so adjusted as to make the total amount of Security Deposit equivalent to 10% (Ten percent) to the value of work so executed.
- 19. Unless otherwise stipulated all the works are to be done as per General Conditions and General Specifications in the "Departmental Schedule" which means the relevant PWD (W.B.) Schedule of Rates for the working area including upto date addenda and corrigenda, if any, published by Public Works Department, Government of West Bengal. For Road & Bridge works, "Departmental Schedule" means the relevant PW(R)DSchedule of Rates for the working area including upto date addenda and corrigenda, if any, published by Public Works (Roads) Department, Government of West Bengal. The project should be executed as per IS CODE /IRC/MOST/MORTH standards regarding the quality of materials and various items of works.
- 20. Deduction of Income Tax from the Contractor's Bill will be made as per latest Govt, rules.
- 21. Labour Welfare Cess @ 1%(one percent) of the cost of construction works will be deducted from every Bill of the selected agency. GSTIN, Royalty &all other statutory levy/ Cess will have to be borne by the contractor as per latest Govt. Rules and the rate in the B.O.Q. inclusive of all the taxes &cess stated above.
- 21. a. Deduction of GST shall be made as per latestGovt. Rules.
- b. Latest Imposition of any taxes /law by the Govt. shall be imposed.
- 22. The Agency will be liable to maintain the work at working portion at the appropriate service level to the satisfaction of the Superintending Engineer, WBTDCL at his own cost for a period of Security Period from the date of completion of the work. If any defect/damage is found during the period as mentioned above, the Agency shall make the same good at his own cost. Failure to do so, penal action against the Agency will be imposed by the Department as deem fit. The Agency will have to quote his rate considering the above aspect. Also the successful Tenderers shall have to execute the work in such a manner so that appropriate service level of the work is kept during progress of work and the period of Security Period from the date of successful completion of the work to the entire satisfaction of the Superintending Engineer, WBTDCL may be considered towards release of "Security Deposit".
- 23. In case of ascertaining Authority at any stage of application or execution of work necessary registered power of attorney is to be produced.

C) In this connection self-declaration (proforma enclosed) shall also have to be submitted along with the tender and it should be declared that statement of fact related to the mode of ownership of machineries are true and it also to be clearly stated that required specified machineries shall be installed at the working site within 45 days (maximum from the date of L.O.A./ work order) (As mentioned in ITB *Section B form IV*).

Specified machineries shall be installed at the working site within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of Work order if the machineries are required in the very initial stage of the Work, otherwise machineries shall be installed at the working site well ahead of the actual requirement as per agency's submitted work programme. - c) Unauthorized use of one's name/ digital signature certificate for purpose of bidding process.
- d) Any documented unsolicited attempt by a bidder to unduly influence the outcome of the bidding in his favour.
- e) Refusal or failure to post a self-declaration to the effect of any previous debarment imposed by any other department of State Government and /or Central Government.
- f) All other acts that tend to defeat the purpose of the competitive bidding such as lodging false complain about any bidder, lodging false complain about any officer duly authorized by the department, restraining any interested bidder to participate in the bidding process, etc.
- g) Assignment and subcontracting of the contract or any part thereof without prior written approval of the procuring entity.

- m) Failure by the contractor to fully and faithfully comply with its contractual obligations without valid cause, or failure by the contactor to comply with any written lawful instruction of the procuring entity or its representative(s) pursuant to the implementation of the contract.
- n) For the procurement of consultancy service contracts, poor performance by the consultant of his services arising from his fault or negligence. Any of the following acts by the consultant shall be construed as poor performance.
 - i) Non-deployment of competent technical personnel, competent engineers and or work supervisors:
 - ii) Non-deployment of committed equipment, facilities, support staff and manpower:and
 - iii) Defective design resulting in substantial corrective works in design and or construction:
 - iv) Failure to deliver critical outputs due to consultant's fault or negligence: and
 - v) Specifying materials which are inappropriate and substandard or way above acceptable standards leading to high procurement cost.
 - vi) Allowing defective workmanship or works by the contractor being supervised by the consultant.
- o) For the procurement of goods, unsatisfactory progress in the delivery of the goods by the manufacturer, supplier or distributor arising from his fault or negligence and or unsatisfactory or inferior quality of goods, visa vis as laid down in the contract.
- p) Wilful or deliberate abandonments or non-performance of the project or contract by the contractor resulting to substantial breach thereof without lawful and or just cause.

- 44. A)The Bidder, at the Bidder's own responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit and examine the site of works and its Surroundings and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a contract for the work as mentioned in the Notice inviting Tender, the cost of visiting the site shall be at the Bidder's own expense.

55 Plantation of Trees

During implementation of various projects of the department trees are felled as necessary for implementation of the projects after proper permission from Forest Department. Plantation and nurturing of five trees for every tree felled should be replenished by new plantation; defect liability period has to cover this aspect also.
